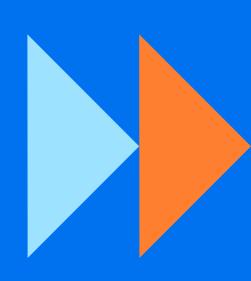


## A GUIDE TO YOUR INVESTMENT REPORT

### Your investment report

Performance of your investments
